Elected to the Leon County Commission in 2022 to represent District 2, Christian Caban is a lifelong Floridian with deep roots in public service and entrepreneurship. Raised in Ocala and educated at Tallahassee State College and Florida State University, he earned a degree in Chemical Science with a minor in entrepreneurship. After college, he built a successful career in the hospitality industry, launching multiple businesses in Leon County. He now applies his business acumen to governance, championing infrastructure improvements, economic development, youth services, and environmental initiatives. His early achievements include launching Florida's first microgrant program for tornado relief, expanding paid parental leave, lighting rural bus stops, and constructing sidewalks in underserved communities.

Commissioner Caban is known for his fiscally responsible approach to budgeting and his commitment to rural infrastructure, including road resurfacing, septic-to-sewer conversions, and safety enhancements along key corridors like State Road 20. Beyond policy, he's a dedicated advocate for underprivileged youth, having served as vice chair of the Children's Home Society advisory board and leading numerous community events and fundraisers. He sponsors annual district-wide celebrations and back-to-school drives and serves on several boards including the Downtown Redevelopment Commission, Circuit 2 Juvenile Justice Board, and the Lake Talquin State Forest Advisory Board. His leadership reflects a hands-on, community-first philosophy rooted in both compassion and pragmatism.
