Amendment/No Cost Extension - AW-000000464 - Civic Literacy Excellence Initiative: Coaches and Captains 12/03/2021 (version 0)

*(Civic Literacy Excellence Initiative: Coaches and Captains:*

*To address learning loss among all students in all subgroups. These funds are provided to increase the capacity of FDOE to support and reinforce standards implementation, provide sustained professional learning, and contribute to projects that support Florida's priorities for civic literacy).*

This amendment provides a no cost extension of the grant through August 31, 2026, to complete remaining project activities.

Amendment/No Cost Extension - AW-000000748 - Mathematics Regional Directors and Coaches 25/26 07/01/2025 (version 0)

*(Mathematics Regional Directors and Coaches 25/26: To address learning loss among all students in all subgroups. These funds are provided to increase the capacity of FDOE to support and reinforce standards implementation, provide sustained professional learning, and contribute to projects that support Florida's priorities for mathematics literacy).*

This amendment provides a no cost extension of the grant through August 31, 2026, to complete remaining project activities.

Amendment/No Cost Extension - AW-000000769 - Holocaust Task Force FY 25/26 07/01/2025 (version 0)

*(Holocaust Task Force FY 25/26: Promote Holocaust education, ensuring that the history of the Holocaust itself is emphasized, at the annual state meeting of the FL Assoc. of Social*

*Studies Supervisors and the FL Council of the Social Studies, including the sharing of updated Curriculum Guides).*

This amendment provides a no cost extension of the grant through July 31, 2026, to complete remaining project activities.

Amendment - AW-000000761 - Advanced Traffic Homicide Investigation Training F 10/01/2025 (version 1)

*(Advanced Traffic Homicide Investigation Training FY 25/26: Providing State Agencies, Sheriff's Offices, and Police Departments throughout Florida with the different levels of traffic-homicide investigations).*

This amendment provides an increase in funds by \$25,000.00 for funding additional traffic homicide training classes for Florida Law Enforcement Officers. This additional funding will increase the award total from \$130,000.00 To \$155,000.00.

Amendment - AW-000000547 - Florida Job Growth FY 22-26 01/25/2023 (version 0)

*(Florida Job Growth FY 22-26: Expansion of Dental and Surgical Tech programs through investment in equipment and facilities).*

This amendment provides a reallocation of funds in the amount of \$140,000.00 for one additional deliverable line for the purposes of marketing and recruitment.
